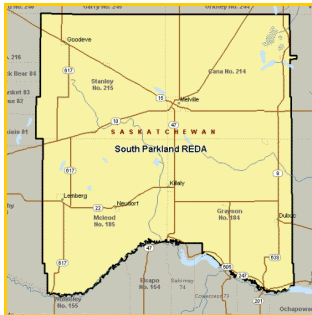

The education system contained within South Parkland REDA ranges from Kidsville, play-school and pre-Kindergarten, all located in Melville at the Community Works Center to Elementary, Junior high and High school to the Parkland Regional College.

Melville Community Works

Kidsville is a safe, affordable indoor play-ground for children aged six and under. In addition, this environment provides support and opportunities for interaction among the families of the children.



Magic Moments Playschool has been in operation for over 20 years in the community of Melville, it is a co-operative playschool run by a parent board elected by the parents. They offer both 3 year old and 4 year old classes. Classes run two days a week for two hours each time.

The **Pre-Kindergarten** program is for children ages three and four, who reside in the Melville area. This early childhood program will create learning opportunities for children who may require additional support and guidance in their everyday lives. This program provides a safe and nurturing environment, modeling the values of care and respect, to prepare students for a successful beginning of school. **306-728-4494**

North Valley Elementary

North Valley Elementary School, located in Neudorf, is a Kindergarten to grade six school, with attendance from the communities of Neudorf, Lemberg and Abernethy. They have an
